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General Information for SEPTEMBER

- 1. **Welcome back AJAX!** We hope that everyone had a safe and enjoyable summer. This document is called Routine Orders (RO's) and will be sent home on a monthly basis. You are responsible for being on time and appropriately dressed for all activities. All questions and concerns go through the divisional system (see next section).
- *NEW CADETS / PARENTS At this time only cadets are allowed in the building. Parents/Guardians, please stick around outside the first night and staff will be outside to help answer any questions or to pick up paperwork. Please bring the following with you when you arrive:
 - a. Health Card (we need to see it)
 - b. Birth Certificate or proof of Canadian Citizenship (we need to see it)
 - c. Proof of vaccination (if you have) including the date of 2nd vaccination
 - d. Non-Medical Mask
 - e. Completed application (if you didn't submit electronically)
- 3. **COVID-19**: Current direction regarding the management of COVID-19 in the cadet program can be found publicly in CANCDTGENS <u>Click Here</u> to see. Here are the current directions for Ajax:
 - a. Vaccines are not mandatory for cadets. However, there are some limitations in place.
 As a result of this, if you are vaccinated we need the date of 2nd vaccination, with proof, if you have it. Please bring the proof with you on a Wednesday night.
 - b. Non-Medical Masks (NMM) are not mandatory at cadet activities. However, cadets are expected to have NMM on their person when coming to cadets. If we are doing activities that require close contact, cadets may be asked to put them on. *Anyone that wants to wear a mask will be welcomed and encouraged to do so. We want everyone to comfortable when they get here, whatever that looks like for each cadets.
- 4. **MANDATORY TRAINING** in order for all cadets to participate in the program we have certain events that are mandatory. Cadets are expected to attend all mandatory training, with limited exception. Everything listed in the table above is mandatory. On the calendar everything highlighted in yellow is the mandatory training. This includes, but is not limited to Wednesday's and some weekends.
- 5. **UNIFORMS** Returning cadets, if you outgrew uniform parts or things went missing etc. over the summer, make sure you see supply and get it sorted out starting Sep 7. Bring the parts you need to replace so we can find the correct new size.
- 6. SAIL TRAINING Sailing is back!! The long wait is over and we are setting sail for Hamilton on September 24/25. This is a mandatory event for all cadets. Drop off and pick for the bus both days will be at the Ship (75 Cardigan), timings to be confirmed (approx. 0700/1800). A separate handout and announcement will go home for specific details like what to wear/bring, lunch, etc.
- 7. **SEAMANSHIP TRAINING** Our first mandatory training day will be focused on Seamanship training and is happening on *October 1, 2022,* at the Ship, dress is C5. Drop off no later than 0900 and pick up is at 1700. Lunch is provided. Bring a water bottle. Again, a separate handout and announcement will go home.
- 8. **SENIOR HANDS** C/PO's (PO1+), we will be meeting on Sat., Sep. 10, from 1300-1600, at the Ship. This is a critical meeting as we need to discuss the training plan and your roles and

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responsibilities for this training year. PLEASE BE THERE. Dress is C5 for this activity.

- 9. **POPPY CAMPAIGN** Every year we participate in the Poppy Campaign for Remembrance Day by volunteering our time to the local Guelph Legion. The campaign is spread out over two weekends, Fri-Sun, and is broken into several shifts. Each cadet is expected to participate in a minimum number of shifts as part of their community service requirements. Cadets are spread out across the City, handing out Poppies for people to wear. More details to follow.
- 10. **WEBSITE** Our website is the official method of communication to ensure we reach everyone with important announcements. <u>All cadets and parents</u> are asked to sign up with either an email address or phone number that notifications will be automatically sent to. The banner across the top of the website will also have updates, alerts, cancellations, etc. as they occur in real time. On the website at <u>www.rcsccajax.ca</u> go the 'REGISTER' title on the banner and create an account.
- 11. **GOOGLE CLASSROOM** All cadets need to sign up for our Google Classroom. Only cadets may register with their personal emails and join the Classroom. This is where we post all information the cadets will need to participate fully in both virtual and in-person training. Please register the cadet using the following link <u>Click Here</u>, or using the class code <u>riko4zl</u>.
- 12. **CADET365** returning cadets should already be familiar with this and new cadets will be sent home with instructions on how to join shortly. All cadets are given a Microsoft Teams account for us to use which they will need to monitor, and an email address. Eventually Teams will replace our Google Classroom as the virtual platform for the program. More details <u>Click Here</u>.
- 13. **PHASE** Training There is a new component to the program this year called Promoting Healthy and Safe Experiences (PHASE for short). This is program designed to bring issues or concerns that youth face in today's world. It is an inclusive program and all cadets are required to participate. Our Phase Coordinator is NCdt Hepburn and any questions or concerns can be directed to her at <u>m.hepburn@rcsccajax.ca</u>.
- 14. BAND We are not sure yet if/when we will be starting up again. Stay tuned.
- 15. **RANGE PRACTICES** run on most Monday nights, 1830-2130 at the Ship. SLt Horner & NCdt Hepburn are in charge of the range team. The first three nights in September are for cadets that have previously participated only. First year cadets and those that have not been out yet will be allowed to join in October.
- 16. **ORIENTEERING COMPETITION** This year's competition occurs on October 15, 2022. No experience is necessary to participate. Interested cadets should submit their name to the XO. We can take 3 female and 3 male cadets (separate teams), individuals may be considered if a full team is not available. More details to follow for those cadets selected to go.

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Divisional Corner

To ensure maximum efficiency and 24-hour operation, personnel aboard a ship are divided into watches. Each watch has duties and responsibilities, as well as specific positions held within. There are two systems for organizing a ship's company into watches. The first is a two-watch system, referred to as the port and starboard watch. This watch system may also be broken into four watches (first of port, second of port, first of starboard, and second of starboard). The second type is a three-watch system, called the red, white, and blue watch.

RCSCC Ajax uses a two-watch system, and is also referred to as the divisional system. The divisional system is designed to handle all questions or concerns that come from Cadets. It is important that you understand how this system works and that you use it effectively. If you have any questions or concerns the first person you contact is your Divisional Petty Officer (DPO).

- 1. Fill out a Request Form and submit it to your DPO (if you know ahead of time).
- 2. If you haven't completed a Request Form;
 - a. On the day of your absence;
 - i. contact your DPO and explain your absence (by phone or email);
 - ii. send an email to info@rcsccajax.ca and explain your absence; and/or
 - iii. phone the cadet building (519-836-4530) and leave a voice message explaining your absence.
- 3. If you follow the procedure at #2, you will be marked on the attendance as Absent with Leave.
- 4. If you do not let us know you will be absent you will be marked on the attendance as Absent without Leave (AWOL).
- 5. Missing mandatory activities, or poor attendance, could have an impact on training results and might have negative consequences (withholding privileges, promotions, etc.).
