## Remembrance Day Activity 2022 – DIY Heritage Minutes Video



- 1. In groups, you will be creating your own 1 minute heritage video to honour Remembrance Day by choosing a prominent Canadian figure, event, or symbol.

- 3. When you arrive on Wed. Nov. 9 you will be split into your groups and have 20 minutes to choose and brainstorm your concept. You will create a basic script / figure 'storyboard' using the template provided.
- 4. You will then have 30-40 minutes to record your video. You need to have a cell phone, camera, or other electronic device to record with. Do not copy an existing video; it can be the same subject but a new concept. Your video must:
  - a. Be 45 60 seconds long; and
  - b. Include every member of your group.
- You have access to almost everything inside and outside the building, but need to bring any props or extras for your video. You only have what you have with you on Wednesday night.
- 6. Each group will be asked to present their storyboard and concept to the Corps, and if time allows we will share the videos with everyone (or we will arrange a suitable time another night). Exceptional videos may be shared on the Corps website or other online platforms, as authorized by the CO.
