General Information for NOVEMBER

- 1. **POPPY CAMPAIGN Nov. 3, 4, 5** Thank you to everyone who participated in Weekend #1 of Poppy Campaign. The weather was pretty decent and overall thus far the campaign is very successful. Weekend #2 starts on Friday 3 NOV. <u>*Please see Teams and the website for additional information about this weekend</u>.
- **REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE** Saturday, November 11, 2023 and it is <u>mandatory</u> for all cadets to attend. You must be at the Guelph Armoury at 0915 and pick up is at approx. 1245. (7 Wyndham St, Guelph). Dress is C1 for the parade. Wear your parka and black gloves. A separate handout will be sent home for all Remembrance Day activities. (all Remembrance Day activities are eligible for Community service hours for high school students)
- FITNESS & SPORTS Wed. Nov. 15 We will have 4 more nights throughout the training year as part of your mandatory training on Wednesday nights. All of them will be at a school <u>(the location of the school(s) will be confirmed shortly</u>). Dress is appropriate civilian attire for indoor sports (running shoes, shorts, t-shirt). Bring a refillable water bottle. Drop off at 1830, pick up at 2130, as usual.
- 4. **CEREMONIAL DIVISIONS (CD's)** Wed. Nov. 22 Six times throughout the training year we will have CD's. It's a formal parade where we will sometimes have special guests, and cadets may receive promotions, awards, or other special recognition. Parents/Guardians are invited to attend these nights at the ship from 1900 to 1930 (7:00-7:30pm). *We will attempt to do a Corps picture night so hopefully everyone is there! We will also take individual pictures that night.
- 5. **TRAINING DAY** Sat. Dec. 9 Our 2nd mandatory training day will be on Saturday, December 9 at the Ship. This weekend will be focused on seamanship training (rope work, block and tackle, sheer legs). Check Teams and the website for the warning order with details.
- 6. **HOLIDAY DINNER** Wed. Dec. 20 we will have a holiday dinner together with NLCC Achilles to celebrate the holiday season and say goodbye to 2023. <u>Resume</u> – Please provide a resume highlighting your cadet experiences, skills, and strengths that you would bring to the job. No more than 1 page in length. Please email this resume to the XO no later than **1900 on November 7**.

<u>Interview</u> – On November 8, 2023 we will interview each cadet independently and ask you 4 questions that a first year cadet might ask you as a DPO. You don't need to worry about preparing for this, it is meant to be a genuine response like it would be in real time. Don't stress, there's no pass or fail.

Combining the two above, along with input from the Divisional Officer's, the XO will appoint the DPO's at the end of the night.

- 3. If you do not have access to either above and the activity is imminent or already occurring please call the Ship at 519-836-4530.
- 4. If you follow the procedure above, you will be marked on the attendance as Absent with Leave (AWL). If you do not let us know you will be absent you will be marked on the attendance as absent without Leave (AWOL).

Missing mandatory activities, or poor attendance, could have an impact on training results, selection for special activities, and might have negative consequences (withholding privileges, promotions, etc.).
